



# Admissions Requirements - NA Program

**Applicants must be 18 years of age prior to the start of the program.**

**Completed Application:** PDF application is found on the Centra College website.

**Required Official, final High School Transcripts/GED:** Official high school transcript indicating that the applicant has or will complete an approved four-year high school course of study or the equivalent as determined by the appropriate educational agency. Once your course of study is complete, a final official transcript must be submitted prior to starting Centra College classes.

**Letter of Recommendation:** One (1) letter of recommendation is required from an individual, other than a family or friend. References should be from those who can speak to the applicant's work ethic, community service and/or academic performance.

**All admission required documentation must be mailed or delivered to the Centra College Nurse Aide Program at Centra College (Main Campus) and received by 3:00pm on the last day of the deadline.**

**If selected, the Nurse Aide Education Program Coordinator may request an interview.**

*Each applicant is considered individually using a holistic review. Meeting minimum admissions requirements does not guarantee admission.*

Upon acceptance into the program, students must successfully complete a background check and provide documentation of immunizations required by the program. Students must maintain a valid American Heart Association Healthcare Provider CPR card for the duration of the program. CPR training may be provided if needed.

All applicants are required to attend an orientation session. Failure to attend will result in forfeiture of your position in the program.
